“New Method for Calculating Causal Relationships”

At this time I wish to remind you that if you have not already registered to please do so immediately and take advantage of lower registration before May 1. You are also urged to make your hotel reservations early but prior to June 2. July is peak tourist season in Montréal and it is an extremely

busy and popular time of the year.
